

Tech Note: Using InterWrite with Windows 95

Two programs must be in place in order to run InterWrite successfully under Windows 95:

msaardk.exe

Internet Explorer, version 4.01, or higher

msaardk.exe This application installs files that InterWrite, running on Windows 95, looks for. This is a one-time installation. Please find this file on our Web site at <http://www.gtocalcomp.com/webupdate/msaardk.exe> and download it to your local drive.

From **Start/Run...**, Open **C:/msaardk.exe**, where "C:/" is the name of your local drive and the location of the downloaded file. Remember, you have to do this only once.

Internet Explorer Download and install the latest version (4.01, or higher) of Internet Explorer that is supported by Windows 95.
